GUIDELINES

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The participants must stick to following guidelines:-

1. The research article must comprise of not less than 7500 words and not more 10000 words including footnotes.
2. The research paper should be typed on A4 size paper ; font size of the body of the text must 12, font type: Times New Roman, 1.5 Spacing and one inch margins on each side.
3. There should be appropriate footnotes indicating the correct source of information. The footnotes may be typed in font size 9, Font type: Times New Roman, Single Spacing. However two separate footnotes must doubled spaced.
4. A bibliography, mentioning all the articles, books, references, websites etc referred to, should be made at the end.

Each article will be marked on a total of 100 marks. The following is the criteria for marking and the marks allocated to each category:

1.	Structure of Articles	20
2.	Ingenuity of Ideas	15
3.	Issues Covered	15
4.	Language, Grammar & style	15

5.	Use of Law & authorities, reference etc.	30
