Subject: Anti-Ragging Cell

Ragging is a form of abuse on newcomers to any institution. To check the menace of ragging, Gujarat National Law University has constituted Anti-Ragging Cell. The main objectives of the Cell are as follows:

1. To make the students aware of dehumanizing effect of ragging inherent in its perversity;
2. To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence;
3. To promptly and stringently deal with the incidents of ragging brought to our notice;
4. To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.

Ragging is defined as: *Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student.*

Ragging in the University campus is absolutely banned and, hence, any student found indulging in an act of ragging shall meet strict disciplinary action, which may include immediate rustication from the University.
