Guidelines for the GNLU Student Mentorship Program (GSMP)

1. The GNLU Student Mentorship Program (“**the Program**”) shall operate under the aegis of the Students Welfare and Grievance Redressal Committee (“**SWGRC**”), & under the overall administrative control of the Office of the Dean Students’ Welfare (“**ODSW**”).
2. The Program is a completely student run & voluntary mentorship system, with minimal involvement of the Faculty, SWGRC or ODSW, which is limited to administrative assistance.
3. The Program is open to all students & alumni of Gujarat National Law University.
4. The Program consists of two basic pillars – the Student Mentors and the Student Mentees.
5. All communication between the Student Mentors and the Student Mentees must remain privileged and confidential, unless required to be disclosed under the law of the land.
6. Any individual may choose to opt-out of the Program at any point of time.
7. Pillar I – The Student Mentor
 - i. Any fourth or fifth year under-graduate student, or any LLM/MBA student, or alumni, may apply to be a Student Mentor.
 - ii. The Student Mentor should not have any case of disciplinary action against himself/herself. This may be relaxed in special circumstances, upon the recommendation of the ODSW.
 - iii. Each applicant should express their area of interest where they think they have reasonable experience, to be able to provide some mentorship to prospective mentees.
 - iv. The areas of interest may range from Moots, Academics, Sports, Cultural Activities, Debates, Research, Management, Philosophy to General Life Advice etc.

8. Pillar II – The Student Mentee
 - i. Any student who seeks a Student Mentor can apply for the same.
 - ii. The Student Mentee must specify his area of interest in which he seeks assistance and requires a Student Mentor in his/her application.

9. The SWGRC shall periodically map the applications of the Student Mentees with that of the Student Mentors, and notify both the individuals about the allotment.
10. Depending upon the areas of interest, a Student Mentee may be allotted more than one Student Mentor.
